Jacqueline Nordon, HOD of music at Mana College, is the ideal exponent of Klezmer bass, having lead street bands in Europe and now drives this ensemble with character and style.

Anna Gawn, soprano, a classically trained singer from Victoria University, has become a versatile and charismatic vocalist. She is the Kugel's newest member, adding a vibrant layer of expression and repertoire to our ensemble.
